Did you know that I have something in common with the American Saddlebred Horse? We're family! Rocky Mountains and Saddlebreds are part of the family of breeds of gaited horses.



Just like Thoroughbreds have their Triple Crown races, American Saddlebreds have Triple Crown horse shows!

The American Saddlebred Triple Crown consists of the **Lexington**

Junior League Horse Show, held in July in Lexington, Kentucky, the **World's Championship Horse Show**, held in August, in Louisville, during the Kentucky State Fair, and the **UPHA/American Royal Horse Show**, held in November in Kansas City, Missouri.

For an American Saddlebred horse exhibitor, winning at any of the Triple Crown shows is a great feat that many work their whole life to achieve. Earning a blue ribbon at the World's Championship Horse Show makes your horse a World's Champion.


Exhibitors from around the world vie for a prestigious Triple Crown title. Each show comes with a rich history. For example, mentioning the Lexington Junior League Horse Show brings to mind the red clay at the Red Mile on a warm summer night. The World's Championship Horse Show is famous for its green shavings. The American Royal Horse Show is a special place too.




Saddlebred Facts
